- Location:** Bonnyville and District Centennial Centre

- Time:** Tournament begins at 10:00 a.m. sharp!

- Fee:** \$35 (one event or more)
Family (additional members pay \$25 each)
- Events:** Individual Kata, Kumite, Kobudo, Team Kata (note that the Kobudo and Team Kata events will be run at the same time so you can only enter one of these events.)
- Awards:** Custom made medallions will be awarded to all top three finishers in each division. All contestants will receive a participation award. Special awards will be given for spirit and sportsmanship.
- Matches:** All coloured belt matches shall be two-minutes / 3 points. Black (red) belt matches shall be 2 minutes / 3 full points or six half-points. ***All kumite events will be double elimination meaning contestants must loose two matches before being eliminated!***
- Kata:** There are no restrictions regarding a competitors choice of kata, however competitors are advised to perform a kata within their appropriate belt level. All kata events shall be decided by a show of flags. Weapons and team katas will be scored. No illegal weapons (i.e.: wooden nunchaku) permitted.
- Kit:** Each competitor is responsible for arriving at the tournament with a complete Kit, which includes a white, traditional karate-gi (free of any markings other than a dojo crest), a belt, ***white only*** hand protectors, groin protector, tooth guard. Face protectors, glasses and jewellery may ***not*** be worn during kumite events under any circumstances. Karate-gis must be clean and in good repair. Sleeves and pants must be hemmed and cannot be rolled up.
- Officials:** Black belts will be expected to assist with officiating. Formal attire ***must be worn***. This includes a white shirt, grey slacks and a blue tie. A blue blazer should be worn, but is optional. Officials must also have their own whistle.
